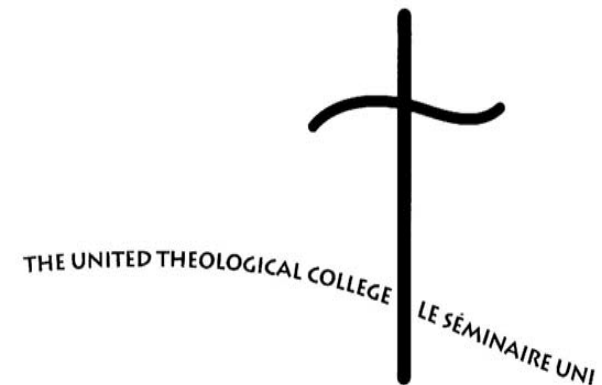

## Glossary/Explanations

### August Intensive:

*Intensive course, offered annually in late August. Involves orientation and continuing reflection on theological education for ministry and personal / professional / spiritual formation.*

### College Retreat:

*Annual College retreat. Intended for renewal, community building, theological reflection, and spiritual practice.*

### Focus on Practice:

*Weekend events on specific elements of the practice of ministry and in preparation for Church Internships. One per semester, normally in September and January.*

### Integrative Paper:

*A tri-college four part and free-standing paper, resourced by Ministry Forums and In-Ministry Year courses.*

### Ministry Seminar:

*Offered in collaboration with the Faculty of Religious Studies, McGill and the Montreal School of Theology, these one evening seminars focus on a particular aspect of ministry. The insights and expertise of a variety of faculty members are brought to a conversation integrating issues of theory, practice and faith.*

### Ministry Forum:

*Ministry Forums I and II are designed to foster theological reflection upon one's call to ministry with the Church, deepen understanding of the dynamics of faith in the United Church of Canada, and develop skills to integrate academic theological studies with articulation of Christian faith and mission.*

### Worship and Community Life:

*Not a course, but an evaluation of involvement in the ongoing community life and worship of the College. Intended for spiritual and personal formation in community. Students should note the appropriate course number on registration forms in each semester of their studies, indicating their understanding that participation in the regular worship of the UTC community is an integral part of their program.*

United Church of Canada Supervised Internship (Ordination Stream)

Students who are Candidates for Ministry in the United Church of Canada (UCCan) must complete a Church-recognized supervised Internship prior to application to M.Div. III. Normally this 8-month internship runs from September – April or January – August with M.Div. III studies commencing in late August.

Note to students not seeking ordination:

*Students who are not Candidates for Ministry in the UCCan may move directly from M.Div. II to M.Div. III, if they are admissible to the In-Ministry Year.*
